MyFreeTaxes helps people file their federal and state taxes easily and accurately from their computer or smartphone. MyFreeTaxes walks you through the filing process and screens for common tax deductions and credits you may be eligible for, like the EITC or the Child Tax Credit. You can also use MyFreeTaxes to claim any missed stimulus payments.
