To have your taxes filed, please bring with you:

- Copy of Federal and State Tax Returns you filed last year
- W-2 forms – statements from employer(s) showing wages & earnings
- Unemployment compensation statements
- All 1099 Forms showing Pension, Social Security, Interest and Dividends received
- All forms indicating Federal tax paid
- Notices, Booklets and Forms you received from the IRS and NY State
- Receipts & cancelled checks for income and property taxes paid and for charitable contributions
- Social Security Number of each Dependent (bring SS cards, if possible)
- Diskette of Federal and State Returns you filed last year (if you received one)
- Any other information affecting your taxes
